**Bayview Construction secures Indian Riverside Park
capital improvement contract**

STUART, FL (January 7, 2011) – Ken Ringe, president of Bayview Construction Corporation, announced today that Bayview Construction has been awarded a \$1,289, 430 capital improvements contract by Martin County, Florida to construct an overlook park and pavilion at Indian Riverside Park, adjacent to the Mansion at Tuckahoe.

The improvements, which were designed by Bender and Associates, will include a 2,856 sq. ft. one-story open-air pavilion, which will contain restrooms and a kitchen staging area, plazas, bandstand, sidewalks, observation deck, a lawn amphitheater, and a 2,080 sq. ft. faux reflecting pond.

“These additions will certainly make Indian Riverside Park one of the waterfront gems of the Treasure Coast and a place current and future generations will be able to enjoy,” said Ringe.

Approved by unanimous commission vote on November 30, 2010, construction on the project will commence after the weather warms and resident gopher tortoises can be relocated.

In addition to Bayview Construction and architects Bender and Associates, the project team includes C. Calvert Montgomery & Associates.
